2/7 To OR for the following ICD-10 procedures:
0W9F0ZZ Drainage of Abdominal Wall, Open Approach
0DBB0ZZ Excision of Ileum, Open Approach
0DBN0ZZ Excision of Sigmoid Colon, Open Approach
0DBM0ZZ Excision of Descending Colon, Open Approach

2/7 op note:

Pre-operative Diagnosis: Perforated sigmoid colon. Sepsis.

Post-Operative Diagnosis: Feculent peritonitis. Perforated sigmoid colon.

Operative Findings: necrotic sigmoid colon-resected

Operative Details: Very foul odor upon entry into the abdominal cavity with murky fluid. This was suctioned and rinsed with copious amounts of warm saline. The descending colon and sigmoid colon were freed up. An area of healthy bowel proximal to the perforation was identified and clamped with bowel clamps. Stapler was used to transect the bowel proximal to the perforation. After completed, the mesentery was dissected down to a healthy segment of distal sigmoid colon. The bowel was transected at this point using stapler as well.

Operative Findings: necrotic fat, muscle, and fascia of the midline wound edges debrided back to healthy tissue

Operative details: The LLQ wound skin incision was widened. There was a significant amount of necrotic fat, muscle and fascia which was debrided with a combination of sharp scissor and electrocautery. Specimens: None
